## **Exposure Exercises**

## Pictures in open shade using various metering techniques and exposure modes.

Shoot in mid-day, the usual wrong time to shoot. Do not use flash. Do not use fully automatic (GREEN) mode. Arrange your subject under a tree so that the subject is in the shade but the background is brightly lit.

Start either in early morning or late evening, but not in the dark. Do not use flash. Do not use fully automatic mode.

- 1. Programmed Automatic and ISO set manually
- 2. Manual Mode
  - A. Take a general meter reading of the whole scene, and expose according to the meter.
  - B. Take a close-up meter reading of your subject, set your exposure. Return to where you want to take your picture, and shoot.
  - C. Take a meter reading of the background, Set your exposure, shoot.
